Planned Giving

Planned giving, or legacy giving, is the practice of designating a gift to a charitable organization during one's lifetime or as part of an estate plan. The gift could include cash, wills, bequests, stocks, retirement assets, real estate, life insurance, annuities equity or personal property. This act of philanthropy serves as a meaningful way to honor your Catholic faith and create a memorial. Donors can minimize capital gains tax when transferring assets as part of a planned gift, further maximizing the contribution to charity.

Donor Categories

Donors can become a DSA Partner, which are those donors who exemplify leadership generosity for donating or pledging \$1,000 or more. The DSA Partner categories include gifts or pledges of:

- \$25,000: Circle of Joy

- \$2,500: Circle of Faith

- \$10,000: Circle of Charity - \$1,000: Partner

- \$5,000: Circle of Hope
